Subj.: Submission of Visit Note.

Sir,

Self and DC, Serchhip visited two border sealing points set up on the bank of Tiau river at the outskirts of Lungkawlh and Sailulak villages of Serchhip District bordering with Myanmar on its eastern side on 28.04.2020.

1. **Lungkawlh Border Sealing Point:** Visited first this point which is located approx. 5 kms away from the village and 5 kms close to the border. It is non motorable beyond this point and closed with bamboo barriers. A total of 6 (six) police personnel {Havildar 1, Naik 1 and 4 Constables (2 with arms and 4 without arms)} were deployed along with 4 VLTF members to perform the duty. Their accommodation is 150 metres away from the place of duty, made of bamboo covered with tin sheet and silpauline, fitted with solar lamp at both place of duty and accommodation.
2. **Sailulak Border Sealing Point:** Located approx. 13 kms away from the village and very close to the border i.e. 3 kms. It is non motorable beyond this point during rainy season and closed with bamboo barriers. A total of 6 (six) police personnel {Head Constable 1, Havildar 1, Naik 1 and 3 Constables (2 with arms and 4 without arms)} were deployed along with 4 VLTF members to perform the duty. The accommodation and duty are at the same place and made of bamboo covered with tin sheet and silpauline, fitted with solar lamp.

It was raining heavily when we visited the place. They do self-cooking by using utensils provided by the SP Office. They all have been given Advance Daily Allowance and ration for cooking before assuming duty. During this visit, each point were given rice 25 kgs (Arham), Dal 10 kgs, potato 10 kgs, channa, cooking oil 3 litres, drinking water 20 litres, sanitizer and mask from the SP Office and silpauline, juice (frooti) and biscuits by the DC Office. They also manage the ration/groceries, vegetables and drinking water if require with the help of Local Task Force. We had an interaction with police personnel and VLTF and no complaint/issues were reported. All the personnel were found healthy, active and alert in duty. However, it was observed that no police personnel were found either having umbrella or wearing raincoat.

Hence, raincoats from the clothing store, SP Office, Serchhip are being sent to the police personnel deployed at the border.
