Please refer to the above cited subject and letter. This is to state that the State Govt. of Mizoram issued Order for total lockdown for a period of 21 days w.e.f 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 vide No. B.13021/103/2020-DMR Dt. 25.3.2020.

However, this order exempted various essential services including operation of Banks, Insurance Offices and ATM. Accordingly, State Police issued Order to all District SsP of Mizoram to ensure effective operation of Banks, essential services etc. vide No. PHQ/IGP(L&O)/73/COVID-19/2020/1104 Dt. 27.03.2020.

Therefore, operation of RBI, other Banks, Insurance Offices etc. is not facing any problem in Mizoram during lockdown period. However, you may inform your staff to carry their Identity Cards during their movement as a proof of identity to facilitate their free and safe passage.

Necessary instruction in this regard have already been issued and in case of any transit/movement problem, RBI, Bank staff are advised to immediately call DIG(NR) (Mb: 9402112102) and SP Aizawl (Mb: 9436153546).
