

BRIEF REPORT ON BORDER CHECK POSTS VISITS


As per Siaha SP Office order No.D/131/RO-SHA/2020/682 Dated Siaha the 28th April, 2020, self and party left Siaha on Dt.29.04.2019 for Lomasu to visit Police border checkposts at Lomasu, Laki, Khopai and Zyhno villages.

Self and party reached Lomasu and met Pu S. Vabeily, VCP Lomasu. He stated that the village consisted of 80 households with around 375 people (approx.). He also stated that the VLTF consisted of 16 members wherein they performed border guarding along with the armed police at 4 (four) entry points at the bank of the river Kolodyne, which is around 500 metre from the village. Self also met police on duty. Border check post at this village is manned by 6 (six) 2nd MAP personnel headed by Hav. Duhchungu. Self visited their check post which was located near the village on the river bank of Kolodyne. They performed their duties well, and had no complaint regarding their duties. Village Task Force members also performed duties along with the police. Police were lodged at Lomasu community hall. The police on duty at this border check post stated no problem. Self also learnt that no Indian army or any other Indian Para-military personnel were present at this village. Police raises that at least one needs to go to Siaha to collect their salaries on their behalf and to make arrangements for their family members whom were at Siaha and Lunglei. Overall situation is calm and peaceful.

Self and party headed for Laki village. Border check post at this village is manned by three (03) personnel from 2nd MAP Bn. headed by Hav. Rohlupuia and one (01) MPRO. They were lodged at VC Court house. Police along with VLTF members performed their duty exhaustively round the clock. Police on duty at this village stated no problem. Overall situation is calm and peaceful.

Self and party headed for Khopai village. There are four (04) personnel from 2nd MAP Bn. stationed at this village, headed by Hav. Lalnuntluanga. They were lodged at VC Court House. At this village the police along with VLTF members performed round a clock duty at the edge of the village. They stated no complaint. Overall situation is calm and peaceful.

Self and party headed for Zyhno village. There are three (03) personnel from 2nd MAP Bn. headed by Hav. Beimotha stationed at this village. They were lodged at High School quarter. At this village the police along with VLTF members performed round a clock duty at the edge of the village. They stated no complaint. Overall situation is calm and peaceful.
